AWARD OF THE CRUDE OIL SALES CONTRACT,
VARIOUS TRACTS WITHIN THE
FAULT BLOCK IV UNIT AND
FAULT BLOCK V RANGER ZONE UNIT
WILMINGTON OIL FIELD,
LOS ANGELES COUNTY

BACKGROUND:

At its meeting on August 3, 1994, the State Lands Commission authorized the City of Long Beach to sell crude oil from various tracts within the Fault Block IV Unit and Fault Block V Ranger Zone Unit, Wilmington Oil Field, Los Angeles County. Some of these tracts are tideland tracts. Huntway Refining Company (Huntway) is presently purchasing the City's share of crude oil from these tracts. Huntway is paying the City a bonus of \$0.235 per barrel above a base price defined as the arithmetic average of the prices posted on the day of delivery for oil of like gravity and quality in the Wilmington, Long Beach (Signal Hill), Huntington Beach and Inglewood Oil Fields, among the postings of Chevron, Mobil, Union and Texaco. The City's share of production is approximately 700 B/D of 19° API crude oil. The present crude oil sales contact is for a term of one year and will expire on February 1, 1995.

A Notice Inviting Bids for a new Crude Oil Sales Contract to run from February 1, 1995 until February 1, 1996 was published in the Long Beach Press Telegram on September 13, 1994, and sent to all known interested parties. Bids were received and opened on October 5, 1994. Exhibit "B" shows the results of the bidding.

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

Fiscal and legal reviews of the submitted bid material were done by the City of Long Beach and the SLC Auditing and Legal Units respectively. Based on the results of these reviews, the highest responsible bidder has been identified on Exhibit "B".

Staff recommends awarding of the new Crude Oil Sales Contract for tracts within the Fault Block IV Unit and Fault Block V Ranger Zone Unit, Wilmington Oil Field, Los Angeles County, to Texaco Refining and Marketing, the highest responsible bidder identified on Exhibit "B".

2. Under Section 10(a) of Chapter 29, Statutes of 1956, 1st. E.S., the specifications and forms for the purpose of inviting bids for the sale of Long Beach tidelands crude oil must be approved by the State Lands Commission prior to the publication of the notice to bidders. The City held a bid opening on October 5, 1994. The Commission must approve the award of the contract by the City to the highest responsible bidder.
