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CALENDAR ITEM

MAINTENANCE DREDGING LEASE

APPLICANT:

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Golden Gate Bridge Highway and Transportation District P. O. Box 9000, Presidio Station San Francisco, California 94129

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands within the Larkspur Ferry channel between San Pablo Bay and the entrance to Corte Madera Creek, City of Larkspur, Marin County.

LAND USE:

Maintenance dredge a maximum 600,000 cubic yards of material from the Larkspur Ferry navigation channel between San Pablo Bay and the entrance to Corte Madera Creek to restore safe, navigable depths for continued ferry operations. Dredged sediments will be disposed of at the United States Army Corps of Engineers approved Alcatraz Disposal Site (SF-11).

TERMS OF THE PROPOSED LEASE:

Lease period:

January 1, 1995 through December 31, 1995.

Royalty:

No royalty will be charged for aquatic disposal. A royalty of \$0.25 per cubic yard will be charged for spoils sold for commercial purposes.

PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Filing and processing costs have been received.

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OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, (g) maintenance dredging where the spoil is deposited in a spoil area authorized by all applicable State and Federal regulatory agencies; 14 Cal. Code Regs. 15304.

Authority: P.R.C. 21084 and 14 Cal. Code Regs. 15300.

2. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the Staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

- 1. FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. CODE REGS, 15061 AS A CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT PROJECT, CLASS 4, 14 CAL. CODE REGS. 15304(g).
- 2. FIND THAT THIS ACTIVITY IS CONSISTENT WITH THE USE CLASSIFICATION DESIGNATED FOR THE LAND PURSUANT TO P.R.C. 6370, ET SEQ.
- 3. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE OF A DREDGING LEASE TO THE GOLDEN GATE BRIDGE, HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1995 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 1995. SAID LEASE SHALL ALLOW DREDGING A MAXIMUM OF 600,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FROM LARKSPUR FERRY NAVIGATION CHANNEL BETWEEN SAN PABLO BAY

AND THE ENTRANCE TO CORTE MADERA CREEK, CITY OF LARKSPUR, MARIN COUNTY, WITH DISPOSAL AT THE ALCATRAZ DISPOSAL SITE (SF-11), AS AUTHORIZED. SUCH PERMITTED ACTIVITY IS CONTINGENT UPON APPLICANT'S COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE PERMITS, RECOMMENDATIONS, OR LIMITATIONS ISSUED BY FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS.




EXHIBIT "A" Site Map WP 6708 Larkspur Ferry Channel Corte Madera Creek MARIN COUNTY
