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APPROVAL OF GENERAL LEASE PUBLIC AGENCY USE

APPLICANT:

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Southern Sonoma County Resource Conservation District 1301 Redwood Way, Suite 170 Petaluma, California 94954

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

State owned tide and submerged lands in Sonoma Creek, Tolay Creek, the north and east branch of Tolay Creek, Napa Slough, Second Napa Slough, Third Napa Slough, Hudeman Slough, Steamboat Slough, Schell Slough, Railroad Slough, Rainbow Slough, San Antonio Creek, Petaluma River and San Pablo Bay, Marin and Sonoma Counties.

LAND USE:

Maintenance and improvement of existing levees.

TERMS OF THE PROPOSED LEASE:

Lease period:

Ten years, effective May 1, 1994 through April 30, 2004.

CONSIDERATION:

The public use and benefit, with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Filing and processing costs have been received.

- Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, 2 Cal. Code Regs. 2905 (d)(2).
- 2. The activity which is the subject of this Calendar Item involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the Staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
- The applicant requests the proposed lease pursuant to a regional permit application to the United States Army Corps of Engineers for periodic improvement and maintenance of levees as described in Exhibit "A", hereto. The work authorized is for levee repair and reconstruction of existing levees only.

- 2. FIND THAT THIS ACTIVITY IS CONSISTENT WITH THE USE CLASSIFICATION DESIGNATED FOR THE LAND PURSUANT TO P.R.C. 6370, ET SEQ.

3. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE OF A GENERAL LEASE - PUBLIC AGENCY USE TO SOUTHERN SONOMA COUNTY RESOURCE CONSERVATION DISTRICT, EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 1994 THROUGH APRIL 30, 2004, FOR MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENT OF EXISTING LEVEES. SUCH LEASE IS CONTINGENT UPON APPLICANT'S COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE PERMITS, RECOMMENDATIONS, OR LIMITATIONS ISSUED BY FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS.

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The State owned lands in the beds of and along the levees of the Petaluma River and San Pablo Bay adjacent to the parcels of land shown in the U.S. Corp of Engineers Public Notice No. 19991N39 dated February 14, 1994; the State owned lands in the bed of and along the levees of San Antonio Creek adjacent to the parcels of land shown in the U.S. Corp of Engineers Public Notice No. 19989N46 dated February 14, 1994; and, the State owned lands in the beds of and along the levees of Sonoma Creek, Tolay Creek, the north and east branch of Tolay Creek, Napa Slough, Second Napa Slough, Third Napa Slough, Hudeman Slough, Steamboat Slough, Schell Slough, Railroad Slough, Rainbow Slough and San Pablo Bay adjacent to the parcels of land shown in the U.S. Corp of Engineers Public Notice No. 19990N54 dated February 14, 1994.
