DREDGING LEASE

APPLICANT:

City of San Diego 3033 Fifth Avenue, Suite 335 San Diego, California 92101

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

Granted mineral reservation lands in Mission Bay, San Diego County.

LAND USE:

Dredge a maximum 48,000 cubic yards of sediment from East Ski Island and Mission Bay Channel Shoal, as part of Phase I of the Mission Bay Shoreline Protection Project. Sediments will be stockpiled at Fiesta Island for use in future beach replenishment projects.

PROPOSED LEASE TERMS:

Lease Period:

Two years beginning December 1, 1994 through November 30, 1996.

Royalty:

No royalty shall be charged as material will be used for public benefit. A minimum of \$0.25 per cubic yard shall be charged for material used for private benefit or commercial sale purposes.

PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

·Filing and processing fees have been received.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The City of San Diego prepared and circulated an EIR (SCH 89040527) for this project. That EIR was certified by the City on May 7, 1990. However, as a result of circulation of the project through the United States Army Corps of Engineers Public Notice (PNCELA 94-054-DZ), the City was required to prepare a Project Phase I Eelgrass Mitigation Program. That Mitigation Program was not formally adopted by the City.
- 2. On August 11, 1994, the California Coastal Commission granted permit #6-93-165 for this project under its certified regulatory program (14 Cal. Code Regs 15251 (c)). That permit requires the City to implement all elements of the Eelgrass Mitigation Program, as modified by the Coastal Commission.
- 3. Staff has reviewed the document, incorporated herein by reference, and determined that the conditions, as specified in 14 Cal. Code Regs 15253 (b), have been met for the Commission to use the environmental analysis document certified by the Coastal Commission as a substitute for a Negative Declaration in order to comply with the requirements of CEQA.
- 4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

- 1. FIND THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS DOCUMENT (COASTAL DEVELOPMENT PERMIT #6-93-165) WAS CERTIFIED FOR THIS PROJECT BY THE CALIFORNIA COASTAL COMMISSION UNDER ITS CERTIFIED PROGRAM (14 CAL. CODE REGS. 15251 (c)), THAT THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION HAS REVIEWED SUCH DOCUMENT AND THAT THE CONDITIONS AS SPECIFIED IN 14 CAL. CODE REGS. 15253 (b) HAVE BEEN MET.
- 2. FIND THAT THIS ACTIVITY IS CONSISTENT WITH THE USE CLASSIFICATION DESIGNATED FOR THE LAND PURSUANT TO P.R.C. 6370, ET SEQ.
- 3. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE OF A TWO YEAR DREDGING LEASE TO THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 1, 1994 THROUGH NOVEMBER 30, 1996. SAID LEASE SHALL ALLOW DREDGING A MAXIMUM VOLUME OF 48,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FROM EAST SKI ISLAND AND MISSION BAY CHANNEL SHOAL IN MISSION BAY, SAN DIEGO COUNTY. MATERIAL WILL BE STOCKPILED AT FIESTA ISLAND FOR FUTURE USE IN BEACH REPLENISHMENT PROJECTS. SUCH PERMITTED ACTIVITY IS CONTINGENT UPON APPLICANT'S COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE PERMITS, RECOMMENDATIONS, OR LIMITATIONS ISSUED BY FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES.
