MAINTENANCE DREDGING LEASE

APPLICANT:

San Francisco Drydock Inc. P. O. Box 7644 San Francisco, California 94120

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

Granted sovereign lands, minerals reserved, at San Francisco Drydock, Drydock No. 2, City and County of San Francisco.

LAND USE:

Maintenance dredge a maximum 144,000 cubic yards of material at San Francisco Drydock, Drydock No. 2, in order to maintain safe operating depths during all tidal conditions. Dredged sediments will be disposed of at the Alcatraz Disposal Site (SF-11).

TERMS OF THE PROPOSED LEASE:

Lease Period

March 1, 1995 through February 29, 1996.

Royalty

No royalty will be charged for aquatic disposal. A royalty of \$0.25 per cubic yard will be charged for spoils sold for commercial purposes.

PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Filing and processing costs have been received.

SAID LEASE SHALL ALLOW DREDGING A MAXIMUM OF 144,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FROM GRANTED MINERALS RESERVED LANDS SAN FRANCISCO DRYDOCK, DRYDOCK NO. 2, CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO, WITH DISPOSAL AT THE ALCATRAZ DISPOSAL SITE (SF-11), AS AUTHORIZED. SUCH PERMITTED ACTIVITY IS CONTINGENT UPON APPLICANT'S COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE PERMITS, RECOMMENDATIONS, OR LIMITATIONS ISSUED BY FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS.

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
