Exxon Company U.S.A. Benicia Refinery 3400 East Second Street Benicia, California 94510

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

Granted mineral reserved sovereign lands in Carquinez Strait, at Benicia Refinery located in Solano County.

LAND USE:

Maintenance dredge a maximum 80,000 cubic yards annually of material at Benicia Refinery in order to maintain safe operating depths during all tidal conditions. Dredged sediments will be disposed of at the Carquinez Strait Disposal Site (SF-9).

TERMS OF THE PROPOSED LEASE:

Lease period:

June 1, 1995 through December 4, 1997.

Royalty:

No royalty will be charged for aquatic disposal. A royalty of \$0.25 per cubic yard will be charged for spoils sold for commercial purposes.

PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Filing and processing costs have been received.

 - a. Served as the lead agency under CEQA;

c. found that the project, as proposed, will not have a significant effect on the environment.

Under Section 15252 of the CEQA Guidelines, the State Lands Commission may use the environmental analysis made by the SFBCDC in its consideration of this project.

Authority: Sections 21083 and 21087 of the CEQA.

- 3. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE OF A DREDGING LEASE TO THE EXXON COMPANY U.S.A. EFFECTIVE JUNE 1, 1995 THROUGH DECEMBER 4, 1997. SAID LEASE SHALL ALLOW DREDGING A MAXIMUM OF 80,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL ANNUALLY FROM GRANTED MINERAL RESERVED STATE SOVEREIGN LANDS AT BENICIA REFINERY, SOLANO COUNTY, WITH DISPOSAL AT THE CARQUINEZ STRAIT DISPOSAL SITE (SF-9), AS AUTHORIZED.
