BACKGROUND:

Negotiated subsurface (no surface use) State oil and gas lease PRC 7375 was entered into on January 17, 1990, between the State Lands Commission (Commission) and Sun Operating Limited Partnership (Sun Operating). The lease contains approximately 33 acres of tide and submerged land in the bed of Beaver Slough in San Joaquin County, California (leased lands). On September 23, 1991, the Commission approved assignment of State oil and gas lease PRC 7375 from Sun Operating to Corbin J. Robertson (Lessee). The Commission consented to pool all 33 acres into the Beaver Slough Gas

Unit on May 26, 1994. State oil and gas lease PRC 7375 is currently producing gas.

Lease Paragraph 29 allows the Lessee, with Commission approval, to assign any portion of the lease to an individual who possesses the qualifications specified in P.R.C. 6801. The lease also specifies that the assignment will take effect on the first day of the month following Commission approval.

In documents filed on May 22, 1995, the Lessee proposes to assign all of its 100 percent interest in the lease to Vintage Petroleum Inc. Commission staff has reviewed the documents and lease files and has found that: (1) the Assignee is qualified under P.R.C. 6801 to hold the lease, (2) the Lessee has complied with all lease provisions and no default exists.

PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Filing fee, processing costs and required documentation have been received and are on file in the Commission's Long Beach Office.

Bond or other security in the sum of \$5,000 has been received.
