CESSION OF CONCURRENT CRIMINAL JURISDICTION AT METROPOLITAN DETENTION CENTER, LOS ANGELES, LOS ANGELES COUNTY AUTHORIZATION TO CONDUCT PUBLIC HEARING

PARTY:

United States of America Federal Bureau of Prisons U. S. Department of Justice Washington, D. C. 90530

BACKGROUND:

The United States exercises proprietary jurisdiction over the Federal Detention Center at Los Angeles, Los Angeles County. By letter dated November 8, 1995 the Department of Justice has requested California cede concurrent criminal jurisdiction over this facility for five years.

California Government Code Section 126 authorizes the State Lands Commission to cede such jurisdiction if the following conditions, among others, are met:

- 1. The United States has in writing requested that the State cede jurisdiction;
- 2. The State Lands Commission has held a public hearing to determine whether it is in the State's best interests to cede the jurisdiction; and
- 3. The United States has agreed to pay for the costs associated with the cession process.

CALENDAR ITEM NO. C50 (CONT'D)

The United States has made the written request for the cession and has agreed to bear the costs associated with the cession.

The Commissioners are requested to authorize the Executive Officer or his delegate to conduct the required public hearing to receive comments on whether the cession is in the State's best interest. Comments received at the hearing and a staff recommendation regarding the cession will be presented to the Commission at a later date.




CESSION OF CONCURRENT CRIMINAL JURISDICTION
