**REQUEST DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY FOR EXECUTIVE OFFICER
TO SOLICIT BIDS AND EXECUTE RENEWAL OF AGREEMENTS
FOR SERVICES FOR THE 1996/1997 FISCAL YEAR**

Commission approval is requested for the following bids and agreements for the 1996/1997 fiscal year:

1. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE (\$700,000) C 9601

Interagency Agreement to provide legal, consultative and investigative services concerning the Commission's interest under Chapter 138 of the California Statutes of 1964 1st Extra Session and in the case of U.S. v. Montrose Chemical. All costs reimbursed by the City of Long Beach.

2. ATLAS REPROGRAPHICS (\$21,010.00) C 9604

Three year contract to provide all labor, materials and equipment pertaining to reproduction of drawings and other materials.

3. TEALE DATA CENTER (\$80,000) C 9635

Interagency Agreement to provide telecommunications, local area network and database development services, equipment, software and support.

4. LOBEL, NOVINS AND LAMONT (\$100,000) C 9662

Legal representation in Washington, DC regarding the sale of the Elk Hills Naval Petroleum Reserve No. 1, implementation of the California Desert Protection Act, and other public land management issues affecting the Commission. Contract process authorized by Section 1233 of the State Administrative Manual.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. FIND THAT THESE ACTIVITIES ARE EXEMPT FORM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL CODE REGS. 15061 BECAUSE THESE ACTIVITIES ARE NOT PROJECTS AS DEFINED BY PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE SECTION 21065 AND 14 CAL. CODE REGS. 15378.
2. AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO SOLICIT BIDS, AWARD AND EXECUTE RENEWAL OF CONTRACTS AND INTERAGENCY AGREEMENTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH CURRENT STATE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES.
