### CONSIDER APPROVAL OF QUALIFYING MILES FOR SUBVENTIONS TO CITIES AND COUNTIES FOR FISCAL YEAR 1995-1996

### AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

See Exhibit "A" for list of qualifying county and city parks and public beaches.

#### LAND USE:

City and county parks and public beaches used for recreational purposes.

### **BACKGROUND:**

Public Resources Code Section 6817 provides for subventions of State tide and submerged land oil and gas revenues to cities and counties, under conditions described below, and requires the State Lands Commission to report to the State Controller the amounts of revenues to be used for purposes of calculating subventions.

### PURPOSE:

To approve qualifying beaches and parks, as required by Public Resources Code Section 6817, as listed in Exhibit "A" attached and by reference made a part hereof.

### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA because the activity is not a "project" as defined by CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

Authority:

Public Resources Code Section 21065 and 14 Cal. Code

Regs. 15378.

- 2. The subventions shall be made to cities or counties that own or operate beach parks (public beaches) free of charge to the public for recreational purposes.
- 3. Fiscal year 1983/84 oil and gas revenues to the State from applicable leases are the basis for application of the subvention formula.
  - a) For amounts up to Fiscal year 1983/84 applicable lease revenue totals, subventionees may receive one percent of such revenues, up to a maximum of \$100,000 for each mile of qualifying beach frontage, or portion thereof.
  - b) For amounts over and above Fiscal year 1983/84 applicable leave revenue totals, subventionees will be entitled to receive one percent of such excess amounts without regard to any maximum limitation.
- 4. With respect to each city and county, the apportionment for any given fiscal year shall be based upon the physical facts existing on June 30 of the preceding fiscal year. As of June 30, 1995, based on verification letters received by Commission staff from

the Cities and Counties qualifying mileage is listed in Exhibit "A", upon which subventions for Fiscal Year 1995/96 are to be based.

- 5. The State Lands Commission shall, at the time of remitting revenues to the State Treasurer, report to the State Controller the total amount of revenue received from tide and submerged land shown with respect to each city or county to which such amount is applicable.
- 6. Subventions for the Fiscal Year 1994/95 are as follows:
