GENERAL LEASE - PROTECTIVE STRUCTURE AND RECREATIONAL USE

APPLICANT:

LOCATION:

A 0.04 acre parcel, more or less, of tide and submerged land located in the Sacramento River, Lot 135, Natomas Elkhorn Subdivision (APN 201-0250-024), Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing floating dock and bank protection.

TERM:

Ten-year lease, beginning November 1, 1996.

CONSIDERATION:

Bank Protection - Public Use and Benefit, with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest; Recreational Pier - no monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 6503.5.

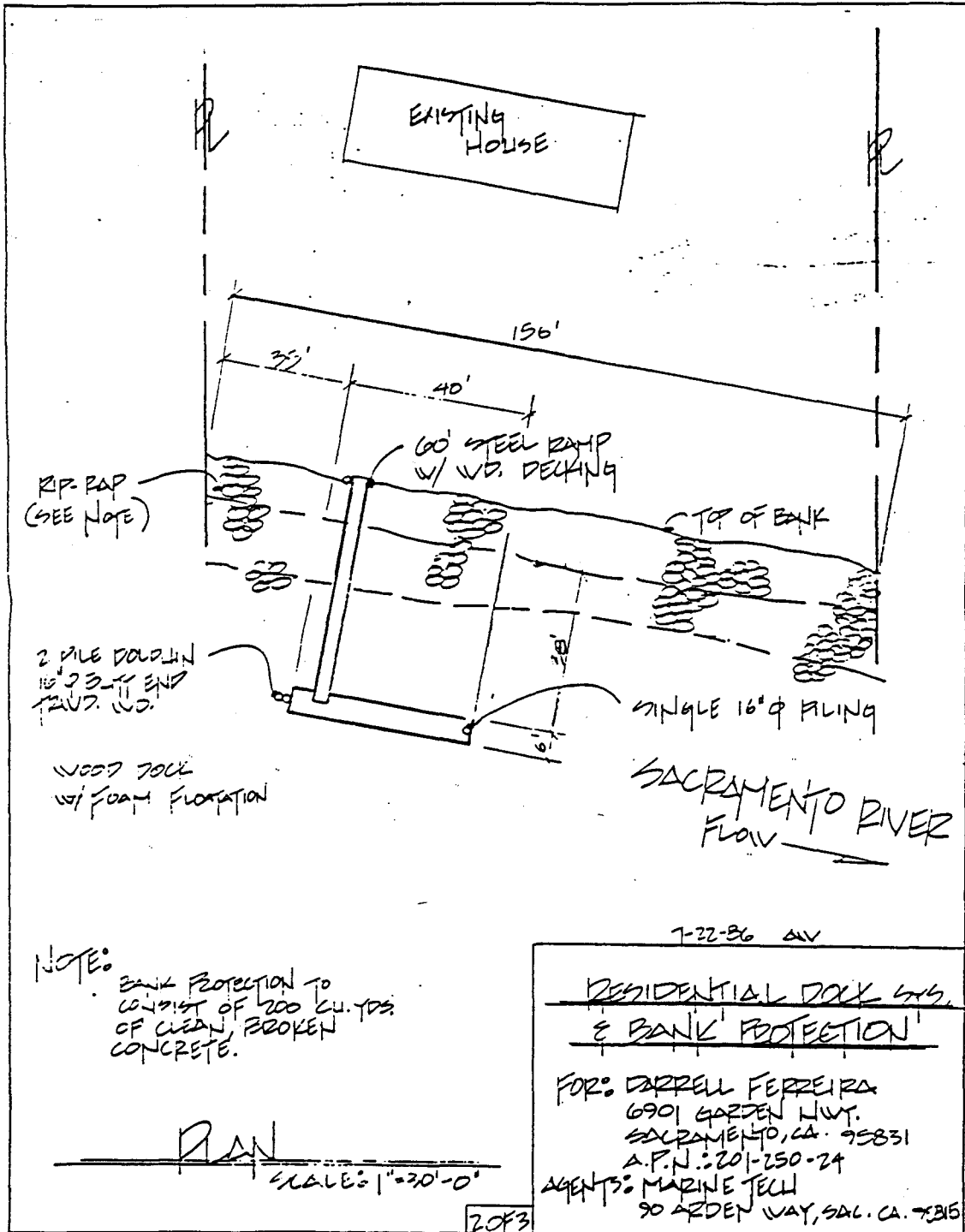
FIND THAT THIS ACTIVITY IS CONSISTENT WITH THE USE CLASSIFICATION DESIGNATED FOR THE LAND PURSUANT TO PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE SECTIONS 6370, ET SEQ.

AUTHORIZATION:

AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO DARRELL AND MARY LYNN FERREIRA OF A TEN-YEAR GENERAL LEASE - PROTECTIVE STRUCTURE AND RECREATIONAL USE, BEGINNING NOVEMBER 1, 1996; BANK PROTECTION - PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST; RECREATIONAL PIER - NO MONETARY CONSIDERATION PURSUANT TO PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE SECTION 6503.5; FOR THE CONTINUED USE AND MAINTENANCE OF AN EXISTING 6 FT. X 40 FT. FLOATING DOCK WITH RAMP AND APPROXIMATELY 200 CUBIC YARDS OF CLEAN, BROKEN CONCRETE ALONG THE SHORELINE FRONTING PROPERTY; ON THE LAND DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

Area to be leased lies directly beneath docks, and walkway, plus a necessary use area 10 feet in width in front of proposed dock. EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying above the ordinary high water mark.

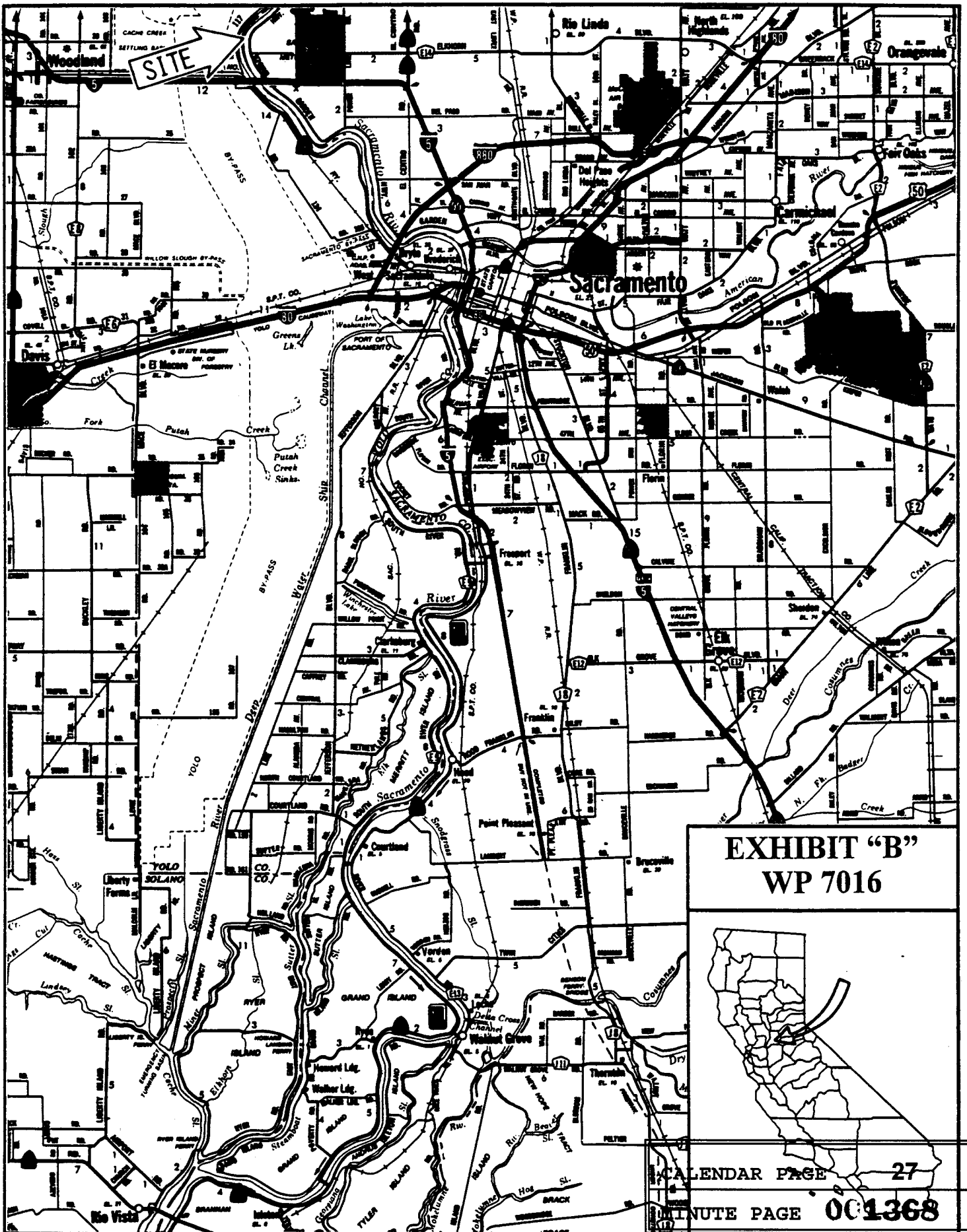
