APPLICANT:

City of Vallejo 55 Santa Clara Street Vallejo, California 94590

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

Tide and submerged lands in Mare Island Strait adjacent to the Vallejo Ferry Terminal, City of Vallejo, Solano County.

LAND USE:

Maintenance dredge a maximum of 8,000 cubic yards of material annually in order to maintain safe operating depths during all tidal conditions for docking vessels. Dredged material will be disposed of at the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Carquinez Strait Disposal Site (SF -9).

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Lease period:

November 1, 1996 through October 31, 2001.

Royalty

No royalty will be charged for aquatic disposal.

\$0.25 per cubic yard for any material used for private benefit or commercial sale purposes.

SAID LEASE SHALL ALLOW DREDGING A MAXIMUM OF 8,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL ANNUALLY FROM TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS ADJACENT TO THE VALLEJO FERRY TERMINAL, CITY OF VALLEJO, SOLANO COUNTY AND DISPOSAL AT THE U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS CARQUINEZ STRAIT AQUATIC DISPOSAL SITE (SF-9), AS AUTHORIZED. SUCH PERMITTED ACTIVITY IS CONTINGENT UPON APPLICANT'S COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE PERMITS, RECOMMENDATIONS, OR LIMITATIONS ISSUED BY FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS. CONSIDERATION: NO ROYALTY FOR AQUATIC DISPOSAL; \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD FOR ANY MATERIAL USED FOR PRIVATE BENEFIT OR COMMERCIAL SALE PURPOSES.
