The Office of the Attorney General, acting on behalf of the State, has, subject to Commission approval, entered into a settlement of personal injury litigation involving certain lands administered by the Commission near Santa Barbara, Santa Barbara County. The settlement amount is ten thousand dollars (\$10,000). The injury at issue was substantial, and the proximate cause of the injury appears to have been certain metal remnants remaining after cessation of oil and gas activity on State-owned property. Both the staff and the Office of the Attorney General believe that, under the circumstances, the settlement is fair and is in the best interests of the State.
