AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Granted sovereign mineral reservation lands at the Port of San Francisco, beneath Piers 33 and 35, San Francisco Bay, City and County of San Francisco.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Dredge a maximum of 1,200 cubic yards of material to facilitate maintenance and repair of four waste water outfall diffusers for the North Point Water Pollution Control Plant.

LEASE TERM:

Three years, beginning March 1, 1997.

CONSIDERATION:

No royalty will be charged for dredged material as the project will result in a public benefit; \$0.25 per cubic yard will be charged for any material used for private benefit or commercial sale purposes.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project.
