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REVISION OF RENT

LESSEE:

Chevron U.S.A., Inc.

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

5.08 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in San Francisco Bay near Pt. Orient at Richmond, Contra Costa County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Marine petroleum transfer facilities.

LEASE TERM:

30 years, beginning March 1, 1982.

CONSIDERATION:

This lease provides that Lessor may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff has conducted a review of the rent under this lease, and recommends that the rent be revised from \$34,739 per year to \$35,648 per year, effective March 1, 1997.

The recommended adjustment of rent is based on adjustment of the prior rent by application of the Consumer Price Index (CPI). Application of the CPI to adjust rents at this time is an interim measure necessitated by budget constraints and resultant losses in staff, and does not obligate the California State Lands Commission to use the CPI to adjust rents other than as specifically set forth herein.
