DREDGING LEASE

AREA. LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign land located within the Sacramento Marina and the main channel of the Sacramento River in the close vicinity of the public boat ramp at Miller Park, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Emergency dredging of a maximum of 25,000 cubic yards of materials in response to the flood disaster of 1997.

LEASE TERM:

Six months, beginning April 1, 1997 and ending September 30, 1997.

CONSIDERATION:

No royalty will be charged as the project will result in a public benefit.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a statutorily exempt project. The project is exempt because it involves a project undertaken, carried out, or approved by a public agency to maintain, repair, restore, demolish, or replace property or facilities damaged or destroyed as a result of a disaster in a disaster-stricken area in which a state of emergency has been proclaimed by the Governor pursuant to Chapter 7 (commencing with section 8550) of Division 1, Title 2 of the Government Code.
- 2. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370.


