AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Submerged lands in Lake Tahoe, near Tahoe City, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

The proposed relocation and 170-foot extension of an existing joint-use pier, the installation of two boat lifts and retention of four existing mooring buoys, as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning April 1, 1997.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

1. The lease is conditioned on lessee's obtaining authorization from the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency for the existing buoys within two years of the authorization of the buoys by the Commission.
