AMENDMENT OF LEASE

LESSEE:

California Department of Parks and Recreation 8885 Rio San Diego Drive, Suite 270 San Diego, California 92108

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Tide and submerged lands in the Pacific Ocean, Carlsbad State Beach, San Diego County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Beach nourishment project involving the deposition of approximately 20,000 cubic yards of material on Carlsbad State Beach.

LEASE TERM:

One year, beginning May 3, 1995.

CONSIDERATION:

The public use and benefit; with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rent if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

Extend the term of the lease for two years beginning May 3, 1996; and amend the land use to provide for experimental discharge of up to 10,000 cubic yards of the previously deposited material into the surfzone. All other terms and conditions of the lease shall remain in effect without amendment.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicant owns the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061),

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the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA under the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. The staff believes, based on the information available to it, that there is no possibility that this project may have a significant effect on the environment.

Authority: Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061 (b)(3).

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

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
