RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANT:

Jil Elizabeth Richards, Kim S. McCarl, and Lachlan M. Richards III 11300 Willow Valley Road Nevada City, California 95959

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, Agate Bay, El Dorado County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Reconstruction of a pier and addition of two existing mooring buoys.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning August 1, 1997.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

Other:

The lease is conditioned on lessee obtaining authorization from the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency for the mooring buoys within two years from the effective date of the authorization of the buoys by the Commission.
