RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANT:

John L. Stevenson % Michael P. Walsh, Executor, Stevenson Properties Fitzgerald, Abbot & Beardsley LLP 1221 Broadway, 21st Floor Oakland, California 94612

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, near Agate Bay, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Retention and repair of an existing pier, and retention of an existing mooring buoy, as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning September 1, 1997.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

Other:

The lease is conditioned on lessee obtaining authorization from the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency for the buoy within two years from the effective date of the authorization of the buoy by the Commission.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. **Pier:** Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project

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is exempt under Class 3, New Construction of Small Structures; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (c) (1). Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

- 2. Buoys: Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 3, New Construction of Small Structures; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (c) (3). Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.
- 3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.


