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**CONSIDER ACCEPTANCE OF THE FULL QUITCLAIM DEED OF
STATE MINERAL EXTRACTION LEASE NO. PRC 7895.2
(80 ACRES OF STATE RESERVED MINERAL INTEREST
SCHOOL LAND NEAR WENDEL),
LASSEN COUNTY**

BACKGROUND:

State Mineral Extraction Lease No. PRC 7895.2 (Lease) was issued to Baldwin Contracting Company, Inc., (Baldwin) on June 1, 1996, and contains 80 acres of State 100 percent reserved mineral interest school land in the vicinity of Wendel in Lassen County, California (leased land). Baldwin used the leased land for sand and gravel production, and has reclaimed the site to the satisfaction of the surface owner, who is obligated to the County to ensure that reclamation is performed in accordance with the approved Reclamation Plan.

Public Resources Code section 6804.1 and Lease Paragraph 25 allow Lessee to make at any time a written quitclaim of all rights under the lease. The quitclaim will be effective when it is filed with the State subject to the continued obligation of Lessee and its surety to pay all accrued rentals and royalties and to abandon the leased land in accordance with Lassen County Use Permit No. SM930001.

On September 15, 1997, the Commission's Long Beach office staff received the document "(Full) Quitclaim Deed". This document was dated September 12, 1997, and quitclaims back to the State all of Lessee's right, title and interest in the leased land as described in Exhibit A of State Mineral Extraction Lease No. PRC 7895.2 with an effective date of June 1, 1996. On April 14, 1997, the Lessee notified the State that all operations were terminated and request the lease be canceled. The letter was misfiled and not discovered until

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September 12, 1997, whereupon, a quitclaim was requested and filed on September 15, 1997. Because the Lessee's notice of termination was timely filed before the annual rental and advance royalty was due (June 1, 1997), it is recommended that the Commission waive its payment. A review of the Commission's files reveals that no default exists on the lease, that Lessee has complied with all applicable laws and lease provisions and has paid all other rentals and royalties due.

2. RELEASE BALDWIN CONTACTING COMPANY, INC., FROM ALL OBLIGATIONS UNDER STATE MINERAL EXTRACTION LEASE PRC 7895.2 EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 15, 1997, THE FILING DATE OF THE QUITCLAIM DEED AND WAIVE THE RENTAL AND ADVANCE ROYALTY DUE ON JUNE 1, 1997.
3. AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF ANY DOCUMENT NECESSARY TO EFFECT THE COMMISSION'S ACTION.
