AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

.05 acre, more or less, of tide and submerged lands in the Sacramento River, near Verona, Sutter County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing 10 foot x 40 foot floating boat dock, a 3 foot x 40 foot ramp, and bank protection.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning June 26, 1996.

CONSIDERATION:
