**ASSIGNMENT OF LEASE**

**LESSEE/ASSIGNOR:**

Pacific Gas and Electric Company

Duke Energy Morro Bay, L. L. C.

**AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:**

62.74 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in the Pacific Ocean, at Estero Bay near Morro Bay, San Luis Obispo County.

**AUTHORIZED USE:**

Continued use and maintenance of an existing marine oil terminal.

**LEASE TERM:**

49 years, beginning June 23, 1954.

**CONSIDERATION:**

\$117,812 per year, with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease.

**OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:**

1. The Assignor owns the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
2. In response to the California deregulation of the electric industry, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) is currently selling several of its fossil fuel power plants including the Morro Bay Power Plant. PG&E has entered into a contract with Duke Energy Morro Bay, L. L. C. (Duke Energy), a Delaware limited liability company, to purchase the Morro Bay Power Plant.

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3. Operation of the Morro Bay Power Plant is subject to a number of existing regulatory permits and licenses including State Lease No. PRC 1390.1. Lease No. PRC 1390.1 was issued by the California State Lands Commission (CSLC) to PG&E for the installation and maintenance of a marine oil terminal, mooring buoys and appurtenant pipelines offshore from the power plant. Currently, the facilities authorized under lease PRC 1390.1 are not actively being utilized and have been placed in "caretaker" status.
4. As part of the sale of the Morro Bay Power Plant, PG&E has requested the CSLC to consider assigning all of its right, title and interest in Lease No. PRC 1390.1 to Duke Energy.
5. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA because the activity is not a "project" as defined by the CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.
