GENERAL LEASE - RECREATIONAL USE

APPLICANT:

Chinquapin Homeowner's Association P. O. Box 6001 Tahoe City, California 96145

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

4.0 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, near Dollar Point, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of two (2) piers and a buoy field containing 132 mooring buoys, as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning July 1, 1997.

CONSIDERATION:

\$1,117, per year; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$1,000,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicant owns the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

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Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
