**PUBLIC AGENCY LEASE AND
APPROVAL OF RIGHT-OF-WAY MAP**

LESSEE:

California Department of Transportation
District 3
P.O. Box 911
Marysville, California 95901

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.84 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in the Feather River, near Marysville and Yuba City, Sutter and Yuba counties.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued maintenance and operation of Feather River Bridge #18-009, including installation of a guard rail, and seismic retrofit activities, as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Continuous use plus one year, beginning December 16, 1998.

CONSIDERATION:

The public use and benefit; with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rent if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA under the general rule that the CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. The staff believes, based on the information available to it, that there is no possibility that this project may have a significant effect on the environment.
Authority: Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061 (b) (3).

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2. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, OF A PUBLIC AGENCY LEASE BEGINNING DECEMBER 16, 1998, FOR CONTINUOUS USE PLUS ONE YEAR, FOR THE CONTINUED MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF FEATHER RIVER BRIDGE #18-009, INCLUDING INSTALLATION OF A GUARD

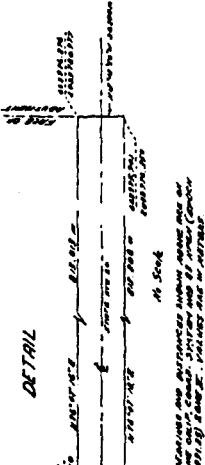
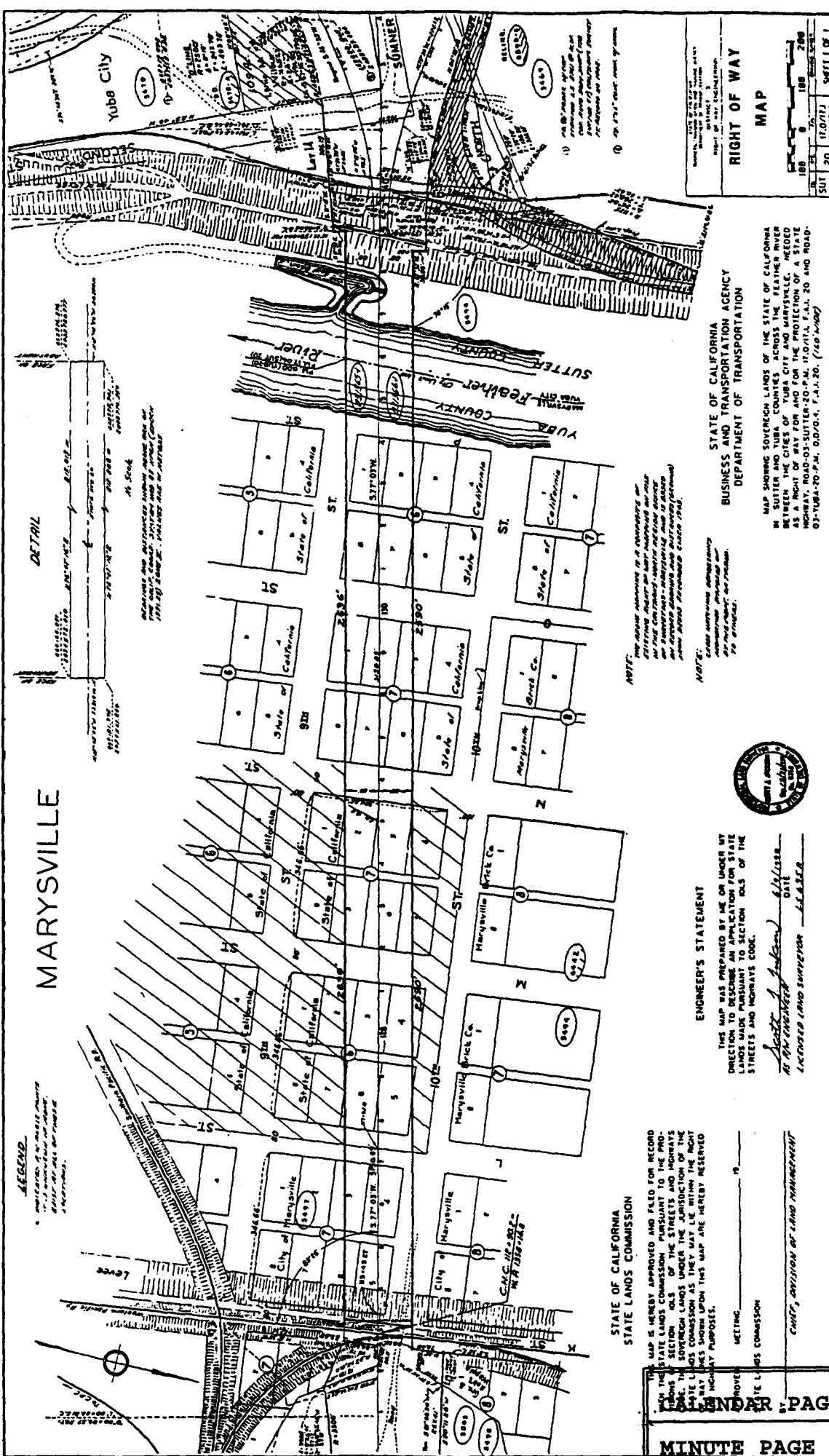

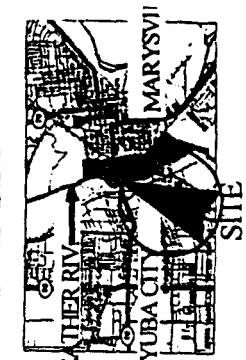
