# REQUEST DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY FOR EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO SOLICIT BIDS, AWARD, AND EXECUTE AGREEMENT FOR PREPARATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT FOR LAYING OF OFFSHORE FIBER OPTIC CABLE

#### **PROPOSED ACTIVITY:**

The Executive Officer request Delegation of Authority to solicit proposals for the preparation of an Environmental Impact Report (EIR), Findings, a Mitigation Monitoring Program, and if necessary a Statement of Overriding Considerations on an application for a proposed fiber optic cable to be laid offshore of California from San Francisco to Long Beach.

The bid will be conducted consistent with procedures as specified in the State Contract Manual and Public Contract Code. The method will be a Request for Proposal with the bid awarded to the firm scoring the highest point total based on predetermined evaluation criteria including price. All proposals and evaluations sheets will be available for public inspection at the Commission's Sacramento office, file reference RFP 98-05. All costs are to be recovered from the applicant.
