GENERAL LEASE - RECREATIONAL AND PROTECTIVE STRUCTURE USE

LESSEES:

Franklin D. and Joann Ramos 3456 Snug Harbor Drive Walnut Grove, California 95690

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

.072 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in Steamboat Slough, at Martin's Island near Ryer Island, Solano County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

A 6 foot x 49 foot floating boat dock, a 3 foot x 20 foot ramp, and a concrete bulkhead.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning June 1, 1998.

CONSIDERATION:

Floating boat dock and ramp:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Section 6503.5 of the Public Resources Code.

Concrete bulkhead:

The public use and benefit; with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rent if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance with coverage of no less than \$500,000.

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OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicant is the owner of the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.


