### **GENERAL LEASE - PUBLIC AGENCY USE**

### **APPLICANT:**

California Department of Transportation Attn: Saaid Fakharzadeh P.O. Box 23660 Oakland, California 94623-0660

### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.69 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in the Napa River, city of Napa, Napa County.

### **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Use and maintenance of the existing Imola Avenue Bridge on State Route 121.

### **LEASE TERM:**

Continuous use plus one year beginning February 8, 1998.

#### CONSIDERATION:

As set forth by Section 101.5, Streets and Highways Code and the public use and benefit, with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rent if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Lease No. PRC 372 was originally granted to the Napa County on February 8, 1949, for 49 years for the construction and maintenance of the Imola Avenue Bridge over the Napa River, Napa County. The lease expired on February 7, 1998. Commission staff was notified by the County that Caltrans had assumed interest in the bridge as part of State Route 121.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under

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Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a) (2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
