**REVISION OF RENT**

**LESSEE:**

Tele-Vue Systems, Inc.  
2260 Brown Street  
Napa, California 94558

**AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:**

0.07 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in Napa River, city of Napa, Napa County.

**AUTHORIZED USE:**

Use and maintenance of two existing overhead television transmission cables.

**LEASE TERM:**

Ten years, beginning December 1, 1993.

**CONSIDERATION:**

This lease provides that Lessor may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff has conducted a review of the rent under this lease, and recommends that the rent be revised from \$160 per year to \$181 per year, effective December 1, 1998.

The recommended adjustment of rent is based on adjustment of the prior rent by application of the Consumer Price Index(CPI). Application of the CPI to adjust rents at this time is an interim measure necessitated by budget constraints and resultant losses in staff, and does not obligate the Commission to use the CPI to adjust rents other than as specifically set forth herein.

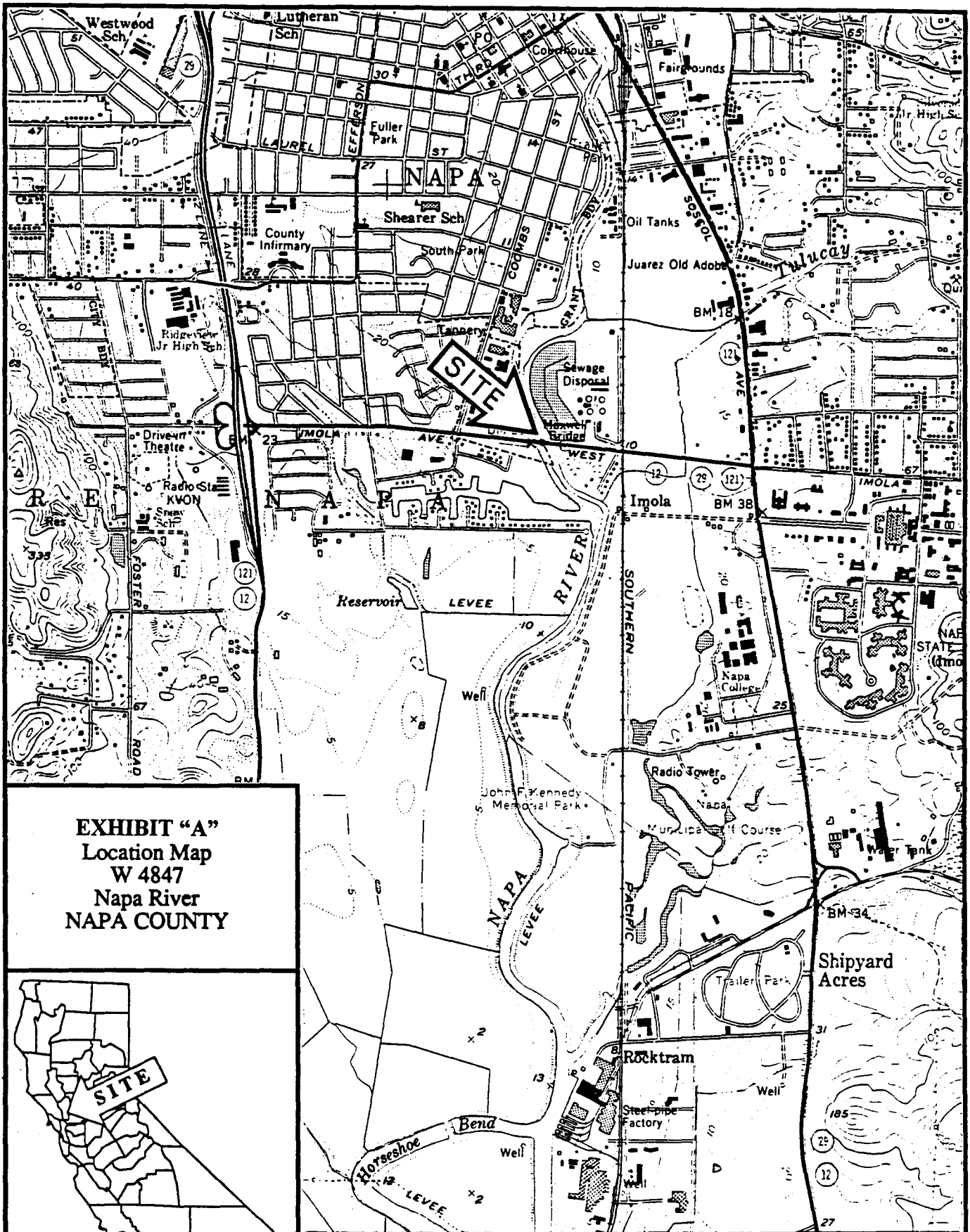
