AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Sacramento River, adjacent to the Garden Highway, near the city of Sacramento, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing 5 foot by 23 foot floating dock and ramp.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning October 26, 1999.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. On October 26, 1989, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Permit with James M. Cameron. That lease expired October 25, 1999. This item qualifies as a rent-free Recreational Pier lease because the Applicant is a natural person who has improved the littoral land with, and only uses the upland for, a single family dwelling. James M. Cameron is now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the
