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# AMENDMENT OF GENERAL LEASE – PROTECTIVE STRUCTURE USE TO EXTEND LEASE TERM

# APPLICANT:

# AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.28 acres, more or less, of tide and submerged lands in Old River at Holland Tract, near the city of Stockton, Contra Costa Countv.

# **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Continued use and maintenance of an existing floating breakwater.

#### LEASE TERM:

15 years, beginning August 1, 1985.

#### CONSIDERATION:

\$612.98 per year; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease.

# PROPOSED AMENDMENT:

- The expiration date of this lease shall be extended from July 31, 2000 to 1. July 31, 2005.
- 2. All other terms and conditions of the lease shall remain in effect without amendment.

#### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

Lessee is requesting a five year extension of Lease because they are in the process of redesigning and reevaluating the needs for the authorized existing floating breakwater. The redesign will require new permits because of the significant change to the configuration and different CALENDAR PAGE 000043 materials being used.
