RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANT:

Dean Giannetto 2881 Calariva Drive Stockton, California 95204

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Calaveras River, near the city of Stockton, San Joaquin County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing 8 foot by 16 foot floating dock.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning May 26, 1999.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

 On September 27, 1989, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Permit with Harold H. Carr, Jr. That lease expired on September 26, 1999. On May 26, 1999, Washington Mutual Bank deeded the littoral land to Dean Giannetto. This item qualifies as a rent-free Recreational Pier Lease because the Applicant is a natural person who has improved the littoral land with, and only uses the upland for, a single-family dwelling. Dean Giannetto is now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease.

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CALENDAR ITEM NO. CO1 (CONT'D)

 Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project.
