DREDGING LEASE

APPLICANT:

Monterey County Water Resources Agency P.O. Box 930 Salinas, CA 93902

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

State sovereign lands in the Old Salinas River Channel, Monterey County

AUTHORIZED USE:

Maintenance dredge a maximum of 15,000 cubic yards of material from the Old Salinas River Channel for flood control purposes. Sediment was deposited from the 1998 El Nino disaster.

Deposition of dredge materials at U.S. Army Corp of Engineers approved upland disposal site located adjacent to the Salinas River.

LEASE TERM:

Five years, beginning December 1, 2000.

CONSIDERATION:

No royalty will be charged as the project will result in a public benefit: however; \$0.25 per cubic yard will be charged for any material used for private benefit or for commercial sale purposes.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

 Mitigation: dredging activities will not occur during periods when adult steelhead are potentially moving upstream (December– March) or when juvenile smolts may be moving downstream (April– early June).

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- A Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for this project by the Monterey County Water Resources Agency. The California State Lands Commission's staff has reviewed such document.
- 3. A Mitigation Monitoring Program was adopted by the Monterey County Water Resources Agency.
- 4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification

AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF A DREDGING LEASE TO MONTEREY COUNTY WATER RESOURCES AGENCY BEGINNING DECEMBER 1, 2000, FOR A TERM OF FIVE YEARS, FOR MAINTENANCE DREDGING OF A MAXIMUM OF 15,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL DURING THE LEASE TERM AT THE OLD SALINAS RIVER CHANNEL. COUNTY OF MONTEREY. DISPOSAL OF DREDGED MATERIAL WILL BE AT A U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS APPROVED UPLAND DISPOSAL SITE LOCATED ADJACENT TO THE SALINAS RIVER. SUCH PERMITTED ACTIVITY IS CONTINGENT UPON APPLICANT'S COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE PERMITS. RECOMMENDATIONS, OR LIMITATIONS ISSUED BY FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS. NO ROYALTY SHALL BE CHARGED AS THE PROJECT WILL RESULT IN A PUBLIC BENEFIT: \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD SHALL BE CHARGED FOR ANY MATERIAL USED FOR PRIVATE BENEFIT OR COMMERCIAL SALE PURPOSES.
