RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANT:

Stephen A. Finn 14000 State Highway 160 Walnut Grove, California 95690

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Sacramento River, near Walnut Grove, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Construction, use, and maintenance of a 30 foot by 60 foot floating boat dock and a 4 foot by 48 foot gangway.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning September 1, 2000.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

Approval of this Item will allow Applicant to construct a new dock.
 Applicant is a natural person who has submitted an application for a
 Recreational Pier Lease. Applicant owns a parcel along the shore of the
 Sacramento River. The parcel is improved with a single-family dwelling.
 Applicant will construct and exclusively use a pier that extends onto
 sovereign lands.

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2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 3, New Construction of Small Structures; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (c)(1).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

APPROVALS OBTAINED:

Reclamation District No. 3 and California Department of Fish and Game.

FURTHER APPROVALS REQUIRED:

US Army Corps of Engineers, Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board, and Reclamation Board.
