0.44 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in the Colorado River, near Topock, San Bernadino County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Installation, operation and maintenance of a 30-inch diameter underground natural gas pipeline. The pipeline is an interstate natural gas pipeline system that extends from Topok, Arizona through portions of San Bernardino and Kern Counties to points of termination in Kern County.

LEASE TERM:

30 years, beginning March 7, 1991.

CONSIDERATION:

This lease provides that Lessor may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff has conducted a review of the rent under this lease, and recommends that the rent be continued at \$214 per year, effective March 7, 2001.
