# TERMINATION AND ISSUANCE OF RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

#### **APPLICANTS:**

Philip D. Chapman and Sarah D. Chapman, Trustees of the Chapman Family Living Trust 170 Camino Don Miguel Orinda, CA 94563

#### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, near Carnelian Bay, Placer County.

#### **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Continued use and maintenance of an existing pier, boathouse, and the retention of two existing mooring buoys as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

#### **LEASE TERM:**

Ten years, beginning December 1, 2000.

#### **CONSIDERATION:**

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

#### **SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:**

Insurance:

Liability insurance with coverage of no less than \$300,000.

#### Other:

This lease is conditioned on Lessee obtaining authorization from the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA) for the mooring buoys within two years after the adoption of the Lake Tahoe Shorezone Amendments-Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and approval of the ordinances based on the EIS.

#### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. On May 9, 1996, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Lease to A. Hunter Land, II. That lease will expire on February 28, 2007. On April 14, 2000, A. Hunter Land, II, deeded the littoral land to Philip D. Chapman and Sarah D. Chapman, Trustees of the Chapman Family Living Trust. The Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling. Philip D Chapman and Sarah D. Chapman, Trustees of the Chapman Family Living Trust are now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease. This Calendar Item will terminate a Recreational Pier Lease that was issued to A. Hunter Land, II, for a pier and boathouse and issue a new Recreational Pier Lease to Philip D Chapman and Sarah D. Chapman, Trustees of the Chapman Family Living Trust for a pier, boathouse, and two mooring buoys, effective December 1, 2000.
- 2. **Termination of existing lease:** Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA because the activity is not a "project" as defined by the CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21065 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15378.

3. **Issuance of new lease (pier and boathouse):** Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

**Buoys:** Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the
