RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANTS:

Albert S. Weaver, III 28400 Greenwood Road Elk, CA 95432

Katherine Barnett Weaver 2433 E. Sound View Drive Langley, WA 98260

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, near Tahoe City, El Dorado County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance for an existing pier as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning December 1, 2000.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance with coverage of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On December 12, 1989, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Permit with Katherine Barnett Weaver and Albert S. Weaver, III. That permit expired on December 31, 1994. The Applicants qualify for a rent-free Recreational Pier lease because the Applicants are natural persons

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who have improved the littoral land with, and only use the upland for, a single family dwelling. Katherine Barnett Weaver and Albert S. Weaver, III, are now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease.

 Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
