#### **BACKGROUND:**

At its meeting on February 5, 2001, the California State Lands Commission authorized the sale by the City of Long Beach (City) of crude oil from various tracts within the Fault Block IV Unit and Fault Block V, Ranger Zone Unit, Wilmington Oil Field, Los Angeles County. At present, the City's share of crude oil from these tracts (approximately 500 B.D) is being sold to Bravo Energy Company (Bravo). Under a contract ending August 1, 2001, Bravo is paying the City a bonus of \$0.762 per barrel above a base price defined as the arithmetic average of the postings in the Wilmington, Long Beach (Signal Hill), Huntington Beach and Inglewood oil fields among Chevron, Exxon Mobil, Equiva and Union 76. The City desires to sell again, its share of crude oil from these tracts.

A Notice Inviting Bids for new Crude Oil Sales Contracts to run from August 1, 2001, until February 1, 2003, was published in the Long Beach Press Telegram on February 20, 21, and 22, 2001, and sent to all known interested parties. Bids

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were received and opened on March 14, 2001. Exhibit B shows the results of the bidding.

#### STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

Fiscal and Legal reviews of the submitted bid material were done by the CSLC and City of Long Beach Auditing and Legal Units respectively. Based on the results of these reviews, the highest responsible bidders have been identified on Exhibit A. Staff recommends awarding of the new Crude Oil Sales Contract for tracts within the Fault Block IV Unit and Fault Block V, Ranger Zone Unit, Wilmington Oil Field, Los Angeles County, to the highest responsible bidder identified on Exhibit A.

#### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulation, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA because the activity is not a "project" as defined by the CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.
