AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

An aggregate of 1,456 acres, more or less, of granted sovereign lands with minerals reserved and sovereign lands in San Francisco Bay, San Francisco and Marin Counties.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued extraction of sand and gravel for commercial use as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning July 1, 1998.

CONSIDERATION:

Land rent of \$2 per acre or an aggregate of \$2,912 per year; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease.

Royalty of 23% of gross sales value and an aggregate minimum biannual royalty of \$140,750; with the State reserving the right to fix a different royalty periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease.

- 1. On June 19, 1998, the Commission authorized Commercial Sand and Gravel Leases PRC 709.1, PRC 2036.1 and PRC 7780.1 with Moe Sand Company. These leases will expire on June 30, 2008. On June 14, 1999, the Commission authorized an assignment of these leases from Moe Sand Company, A California Partnership, to Moe Sand Co., Inc. On October 13, 2000, Moe Sand Co., Inc. merged with and changed its name to Hanson Marine Operations, Inc. Hanson Marine Operations, Inc. is now applying for an assignment of Commercial Sand and Gravel Leases PRC 709.1, PRC 2036.1 and PRC 7780.1. The purpose of the assignment is a merger of commonly owned and controlled corporations with no change in ownership.
- Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA because the activity is not a "project" as defined by the CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.
