AMENDMENT OF GENERAL PEMIT - PUBLIC AGENCY USE

LESSEE:

United States Coast Guard 2000 Embarcadero, Suite 200 Oakland, CA 94606

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.166 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, near Tahoe City, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing pier and one low-level boat lift.

PROPOSED USE:

Replacement of the existing pier as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Twenty-five (25) years, beginning June 8, 1984.

CONSIDERATION:

The public use and benefit; with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rent if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On July 25, 1985, the Commission authorized a General Permit - Public Agency Use with the United States Coast Guard. That permit will expire on June 7, 2009. On February 6, 1991, the Commission authorized an amendment to the permit for the construction of a low-level boat lift. The United States Coast Guard has now advised that the existing pier has deteriorated and the mid-section has collapsed creating a safety hazard. The United States Coast Guard is now applying for an amendment to the

permit for the replacement of the existing pier with a new structure of the same dimensions.

2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 2, Replacement or Reconstruction; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (b).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
