Victoria P. Nichols 45 Havenwood Drive Novato, California 94945

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Petaluma River, Black Point, Marin County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing 362 foot by 3 foot pier, a 4 foot by 9 foot storage shed, a 15 foot by 3 foot walkway, an 18 foot by 20 foot landing pad, a ramp, and a 16 foot by 4 foot floating boat dock.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning December 5, 2000.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On March 6, 1991, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Lease with Victoria P. Nichols. Applicant qualifies for a Recreational Pier Lease because the Applicant is a natural person who has improved the littoral land with, and uses the upland for, a single-family dwelling. Victoria P. Nichols is now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease.
