CONTINUATION OF RENT

LESSEE:

CPN Pipeline Company 50 West San Fernando Street San Jose, California 95113

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.166 acres, more or less, of submerged lands in the Sacramento River, near Knights Landing, Sutter County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing eight-inch diameter natural gas pipeline which constructed the Knights Landing Eastside Gathering System, which is an extension of the existing Knights Landing natural gas pipeline. The construction of this Eastside System brought four additional wells into production and increased the delivery capability of the Knights Landing pipeline.

LEASE TERM:

20 years, beginning January 1, 1992.

CONSIDERATION:

This lease provides that Lessor may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff has conducted a review of the rent under this lease, and recommends that the rent be continued at \$250 per year, effective January 1, 2002.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

This lease was originally issued to Chevron USA in 1992. In 1993
 Chevron USA assigned lease to Montis Niger who assigned to Calpine Corporation, who subsequently assigned to CPN Pipeline.

LAND DESCRIPTION

A strip of land 12 feet in width crossing a portion of the Sacramento River within Sec. 30, T 11 N, R 3 E, MDM, located in Sutter and Yolo Counties, California. The centerline of said strip is more directly described as follows:

COMMENCING at a point that bears S 80° 47' 34" E 864.72 feet from the southwest corner of Section 30; thence N 43° 42' 41" E 82.51 feet; thence N 17° 02' 27" E 288.44 feet to a point located at the southerly toe of the Sacramento River access levee and the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING: thence continuing N 17° 02' 27" E 599.59 feet crossing the Sacramento River to a point at the northerly toe of the Sacramento River access levee and the end of the herein described strip of land. Said point of ending is S 39° 36' 14" W 2523.41 feet from the center of said Section 30.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary low water mark of the Sacramento River.
