#### **RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE**

#### **APPLICANT:**

Wesley Scott Bentley 2375 Garden Highway Sacramento, California 95833

#### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Sacramento River, adjacent to the Garden Highway, Sacramento County.

#### **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Continued use and maintenance of an existing 20 foot by 28 foot single-berth floating boat dock with a 3 foot wide ramp.

#### LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning May 1, 2001.

#### CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

#### SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

#### **OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:**

1. On May 1, 1991, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Permit with Wesley Scott Bentley. That lease expired on April 30, 2001. Wesley Bentley is now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease. Applicant qualifies for a Recreational Pier Lease because the Applicant is a natural person who has improved the littoral land with, and uses the upland for, a single-family dwelling.


