#### **RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE**

#### **APPLICANTS:**

Mark B. Nelson and Lorie L. Wilborne 5 Tarry Lane Orinda, CA 94563

#### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, near Cedar Flat, Placer County.

#### AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing pier and boat hoist as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

#### LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning June 1, 2001.

#### **CONSIDERATION:**

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

#### SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance with coverage of no less than \$300,000.

#### **OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:**

 The Commission previously authorized a Recreational Pier Permit with David P. Nelson and Nathalie J. Nelson, Trustees. That lease has now expired. The littoral land was subsequently deeded to Mark B. Nelson and Lorie L. Wilborne. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling. Mark B. Nelson and Lorie L. Wilborne are now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease.

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# CALENDAR ITEM NO. C30 (CONT'D)

 Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).
