RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANT:

Evelyn Jennie Campbell 120 Beattie Avenue Novato, California 94945

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Petaluma River at Black Point, near the city of Novato, Marin County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing 4 foot by 130 foot walkway and a 10 foot by 15 foot pier.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning May 1, 2001.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On March 23, 1982, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Permit with the Applicant. The Applicant is now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease. Applicant qualifies for a Recreational Pier Lease because the Applicant is a natural person who has improved the littoral land with, and uses the upland for, a single-family dwelling.
