AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Donner Lake, Truckee, Nevada County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Use and maintenance of an existing pier as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, August 1, 2001.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.


SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance with coverage of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because the Applicants are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling. Steven H. Urie and Margaret Ann Urie are now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under



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Class 3, New Construction of Small Structures; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (c)(1).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
