RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANT:

Jerry D. Hicks 1851 Garden Highway Sacramento, California 95833

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Sacramento River, adjacent to the Garden Highway, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing 10 foot by 32 foot floating boat dock anchored with one 3-pile dolphin and one single pile and a walkway.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning July 15, 2001.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance: Combined single limit coverage of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

 On July 15, 1991, the Commission authorized a Recreational Pier Lease with Jerry D. Hicks. That lease expired on July 14, 2001. Jerry D. Hicks is now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease. Applicant qualifies for a Recreational Pier Lease because the Applicant is a natural person who has improved the littoral land with, and uses the upland for, a single-family dwelling.

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2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
