RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANTS:

Stephen Gordon and Christine Gordon 35 Culloden Parkway San Rafael, CA 94901

Jeffrey Lanini and Krista Lanini P. O. Box 465 Tahoe Vista, CA 96148

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, Kings Beach, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Modification, extension and relocation of existing rock crib pier to a multi-use pier, the installation of a boat lift and retention of four existing mooring buoys.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning December 1, 2001.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.


SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

Other:

This lease is conditioned on Lessee obtaining authorization from the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA) for the mooring buoys within two years after the adoption of the Lake Tahoe Shorezone Amendments Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and approval of the ordinances based on the EIS.



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OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling. Stephen and Christine Gordon and Jeffrey and Krista Lanini are now applying for a new Recreational Pier Lease.
- 2. The proposed project is located in an area identified as Tahoe Yellow Cress (TYC) habitat. The TYC is an endangered plant species statutorily protected by the California Endangered Species Act. No TYC was found during the site-specific survey performed during the 2001growing season. Should the demolition, construction or continuation of construction on the site extend into a subsequent growing season, the Applicants are required to contact the California State Lands Commission to conduct a site-specific survey (survey to be conducted between June 15-September 30) for the presence of TYC.
- 3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA under the general rule that the CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. The staff believes, based on the information available to it, that there is no possibility that this project may have a significant effect on the environment.

Authority: Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061 (b)(3).

4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
