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### **LEASE RENEWAL**

#### LESSEE:

Southern California Gas Company P.O. Box 513249 Mail Location 26C2 Los Angeles, California 90051-1249

# AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Kings River, near State Highway 41, Kings County.

### AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of one 16" diameter pipeline used for the transmission of natural gas.

# PREVIOUS LEASE TERM(S):

Original Lease:

15 years, beginning March 1, 1975; with a renewal

First Renewal:

option for three successive periods of ten years each. Ten years, beginning March 1, 1990.

### PROPOSED LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning March 1, 2000.

### CONSIDERATION:

\$100 per year; with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease.

## **SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:**

Insurance:

Liability insurance with coverage of no less than \$1,000,000.

## OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

Lessee has a right to use the uplands adjoining the lease premises.

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# CALENDAR ITEM NO. C52 (CONT'D)

- 2. The Lessee is proposing to exercise its second ten-year renewal option for continued use and maintenance of a 16" diameter natural gas pipeline. The original lease was issued for a term of 15 years beginning March 1, 1975, with a renewal option for three successive periods of ten years each. The Lease was renewed for ten years on March 1, 1990. The Commission's engineering staff has reviewed the information provided by the Lessee concerning the integrity of the pipeline. The pipeline is visually inspected annually. The pipeline is regulated by the Federal Department of Transportation (DOT) and the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC). Commission staff is satisfied that the pipeline is being operated in compliance with the requirements of the DOT and the CPUC. The new lease will require the Lessee to provide written evidence of compliance to Commission staff beginning January 1, 2002, and every two years thereafter.
- 3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15301; Title 2, California Code of Regulations Section 2905(a)2.
- 4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.


