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RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANT:

Thomas W. Berry and Theresa A. Berry

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in Lake Tahoe, at Cedar Flat, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of two existing mooring buoys.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning February 1, 2002.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

Other:

This lease is conditioned on the Applicants obtaining authorization from the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA) for the mooring buoys within two years after the adoption of the Lake Tahoe Shorezone Amendments-Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) and approval of the ordinances based on the EIS.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On August 12, 1991, the Commission authorized the issuance of a Recreational Pier Lease to Daniel and Christine McLoughlin for the two existing mooring buoys. Commission staff was subsequently notified that the McLoughlin's had granted their interest in the adjacent upland property to the Applicants. The Applicants have now applied for a new

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Recreational Pier Lease for the continued use and maintenance of the two existing mooring buoys.

- Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral lands with, and use the uplands for, single-family dwelling.
- 3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.


